Local Taxi Companies Choose Digital Dispatch

Richmond, BC, June 1, 2006 – Two local taxi companies with under 100-vehicle fleets have turned to Digital Dispatch Systems Inc. (TSX: DD) for their advanced computerized dispatch needs.
