Annual General Meeting Results

At the meeting all resolutions presented to the meeting as set out in the Management Information Circular to shareholders were passed, including the special resolution to authorize the re-pricing of 125,500 of the existing Stock Options from \$6.00 per share to \$3.50 per share.
