DDS Wireless' eFleet continues to Grow in Ground Transportation

Richmond, BC, July 13, 2009 – DDS Wireless International Inc.'s hosted Dispatch Fleet Management business unit, DDS eFleet Services, today announced that it has been awarded two new contracts from ground transportation fleet operators for its eFleet™ solution. Both contracts are for three year subscription terms with the possibility of renewals. These contracts represent continued momentum in building DDS's subscriber base and recurring revenues for its Bundled Subscription Services which, in addition to eFleet™, include Taxibook™ and eTransit™.

Gateway Charters Ltd. of Edmonton Alberta operates a division called Skyshuttle, which provides shared-ride shuttle services to and from designated pick-up points within the City of Edmonton and the Edmonton International Airport. The company has selected the eFleet™ solution to provide convenient web-based reservations by their customers and efficient fleet management functions such as digital trip dispatch, GPS tracking, text messaging, GPS navigation, in-vehicle payment and voucher processing.

We anticipate that eFleet will save us 25-35% of unproductive kilometers, which could amount to over one million kilometers per year, so our operations will be both faster and greener."
